RENEWAL OF SCHOLARSHIP

Recipients may receive the scholarship for a maximum of four (4) consecutive Fall/Spring semesters contingent upon maintaining the minimum scholarship eligibility requirements / criteria and availability of funds. **If you do not attend for a semester, you must reapply for the scholarship.**

PORTABLE SCHOLARSHIP

Alamo Colleges students who have received this scholarship are eligible to receive a portable scholarship to continue their education at a 4-year institution in the State of Texas, as long as they continue to meet all eligibility requirements/criteria upon their transfer to a 4-year institution, have completed 60 hours at the Alamo Colleges, and if funding is available.
